





Create a Green Team


The second step in the Sustainable Maryland Certification process is creating a Green Team (or expanding the membership and mission of an existing Green Team-like entity in order to qualify as a Green Team under Sustainable Maryland Certified). This action is mandatory and will earn a municipality 10 points toward certification. It is strongly recommended that your community participates in Green Team training before pursuing this action.

The formation of a "Green Team" is the first step to establishing a community sustainability program. Green Teams leverage the skills, expertise, and life experience of team members to develop policies and plans, implement programs, and assist with educational of portunities that support the creation of a sustainable community. Such entities can go by any name, but the role is the same: lead and coordinate the sustainability activities of the community.

Goal(s):

To bring together a group of community leaders, municipal staff, and community organizations order to establish a Green Team and to create a Green Team that reflects the characteristics of your community.
